

LAKE MILLS MUSIC PARENT'S MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To help those students with musical talent and dedication to achieve a higher level of excellence through outside-of-school enrichment activities. In becoming stronger individual musicians these students will in turn also strengthen the music performance groups they are involved in at LMHS.

The emphasis of this scholarship is based on student musical achievement, ability, and dedication.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Current freshman, sophomore, or junior music student at LMHS.
- 2) Enrolled in at least one music performance class at Lake Mills High School for the entire current and following school year.
- 3) Participated in all required music performances during the current school year, unless excused by the music instructor
- 4) Participated in the Solo and Ensemble Festival for the current school year.
- 5) **At least a 3.33 average in current music classes** or director consent.

The scholarship committee and available funds determine the number and amount of scholarships given each year. **There are four \$200 scholarships available this year.** The scholarship money must be used by the end of September of the following school year. Scholarship money that has not been requested or claimed by that deadline will remain in the Lake Mills Music parents fund. The scholarships may be used for any of the following:

- Summer music camps
- Tuition for Wisconsin Youth Ensembles
- Private Instruction
- WSMA Honors Project
- Other activities as approved by the primary music teacher

Application Requirements:

The applicant must complete the application and write an essay (most be between 200 and 400 words) answering the following questions:

Write about how your advanced music study would impact you and your ensemble group.

Essays should be written at a good high school level. They should be typed with proper spelling and grammar.

All applications are due to a music teacher by 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 25, 2017

Scholarship Selections:

The Scholarship recipient will be selected based on music participation and activities, teacher recommendation and application answers. The scholarship committee will determine scholarship selection. The committee shall consist of the music instructors and 2 other adults. Applicants may be requested to perform for the committee. Students may not receive multiple Music Parent Scholarships in the same school year.
