**Expectations for Lake Mills High School Student Conduct
for Overnight (Extended) / Foreign Field Trips**

On an extended field trip, all students will:

- Follow all school rules and procedures as outlined in the Code of Conduct, Athletic Code, and Student Organization Code
- Follow the directions of all chaperone(s) for the duration of the trip
- Know the emergency plan – where to meet up, chaperone contact information, etc.
- Respect the property and people of their destination – no defacing public property. Any damages by a student shall be paid for by that person or their family
- Inform their chaperones of their whereabouts at ALL times
- Not leave hotel without permission of the lead chaperone
- Remain in assigned rooms after designated curfew, sleep only in assigned room, and will not share or enter rooms of another group or stranger
- Attend ALL scheduled events associated with the trip
- Be prompt and prepared for all activities
- Dress appropriately for each occasion / activity throughout the trip
- Refrain from getting tattoos or body piercing
- Refrain from smoking or possessing cigarettes at any time
- Refrain from consuming, using, or possessing any alcohol or illegal drugs

NOTE: The group leader / chaperones are directly responsible for students throughout the duration of the trip. *Students who violate any of the above rules of conditions may be sent home at parents' expense.* In addition, all consequences outlined in the Code of Conduct, Athletic Code, and Student Organization Code will be administered upon return from the trip.
